The class will begin with a focus on creative writing and end with an introduction to more formal or academic writing. Although the class will be conducted in English and all four language skills will be used, the main focus will be on writing.

(4)授業の概要	This class focuses on techniques of creative writing but also includes an introduction to academic writing. Students will have short weekly writing assignments which will alternate between structured and free compositions. The structured assignments will be evaluated based on content as well as grammar, English expression, and format. Students will receive feedback and will set their own goals for improvement. In general, structured assignments will be written in Google Docs and later posted in eALPS forums. The free assignments will be evaluated based mainly on their communicative effectiveness. They will be posted directly in eALPS forums and will receive content-based responses from peers. The final assignments will be a longer creative essay prepared outside of class and an in-class writing activity.
